



## ARTS TRACKS DESCRIPTIONS

**Drama:** The drama group is for children who are cast in an acting part after being chosen through the audition process. Children must be able to attend auditions on Sunday, July 9<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 – 6:00 pm and must be able to attend the final production on Thursday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30 pm. This group is limited to children in 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade.

**Dance:** Children will learn and memorize choreography and dance movements, to present to the audience during the Thursday night production.

**Choir:** Children will participate in the choir, singing the music that will accompany the other arts presentations and connect the scenes within the drama during the Thursday night production.

**Drumming/Percussion:** Children will play various ethnic drums and percussion instruments (such as bongos, hand drums, djembes, frame drums, boomwhackers) and learn a group piece of music to present to the audience during the Thursday night production.

**Puppetry:** Children will learn how to use puppets in presenting the gospel. They will prepare a puppet piece and present their final work during the Thursday night production.

**Art:** Children will participate in visual arts experiences, including painting, drawing, and other crafts, which will be displayed and used for the set during the Thursday night production.

**Baking:** Children will create the snacks that will be served daily to the campers during snack time. All snacks will be theme-based to go along with the subject of the musical.

**Stop Motion Technology:** Children will learn how to use stop motion animation and create a video to be shared during the Thursday night production. Stop motion animation is a filming technique in which objects (such as clay models) are photographed in a series of slightly different positions so that the objects seem to move. Children will be required to provide his/her own portable device, such as a tablet or smartphone.

**Stage Hands/Production:** Children will learn skills that assist with the backstage elements of production, including helping with set, props, wardrobe changes, and preparing and moving various equipment according to set requirements. This group is limited to children in 3<sup>rd</sup>- 5<sup>th</sup> grade.
