Office Assistance

Time would be flexible, pre-camp

- Prepare folders.
- Organize t-shirt orders.
- Assist with any other office needs that may arise.

Decorating Team

Saturday and Sunday, July 29 and 30, times TBD

- Help plan and collect items for decorating.
- Decorate the lobby, fellowship hall, and classrooms.
- Put up signage on the classroom doors.

Group Leaders

8:45am-12pm Monday- Thursday; 5pm-7:30pm Thursday night during the production

- Serve as the main contact person for each small group of children.
- Check-in and check-out children with parents daily.
- Take daily attendance of your group.
- Guide the small group from room to room to attend various arts tracks.
- Get to know and build relationships with the children in your group.
- Ensure safety and manage behavior of the children in your group.

Arts Tracks Leaders/ Assistants

8:45am-12pm Monday- Thursday; 5pm-7:30pm Thursday night during the production

- Lead or assist with 45-minute arts tracks classes held from Monday - Wednesday.
- Possible arts tracks available include:
 - Drama
 - Choir
 - Dance
 - Art/Set Design
 - Drumming/percussion
 - Baking
 - Puppetry
 - Stop motion technology
 - Stage Hands/Production
- Help incorporate your assigned arts track piece into the final production to be held Thursday evening.
- Assist as needed with the final run-throughs on Thursday.

Floater

8:45am-12pm Monday- Thursday; 5pm-7:30pm Thursday night during the production

- Floaters will be ready to serve in a variety of ways, according to daily needs.

Younger Siblings Choir

9am-9:30pm Monday-Thursday; 6:30pm Thursday night

- If enough campers have siblings who would like to participate, a choir will be established for these siblings.
- This volunteer would lead the siblings' choir rehearsal, teaching them a simple song to include in the final production Thursday night.

Serve as a GROW Buddy

8:45am-12pm Monday- Thursday; 5pm-7:30pm Thursday night during the production

- A GROW buddy is a volunteer who is paired with a camper who needs additional support.
- Buddies may modify content or tasks to meet their camper's needs.
- They may make changes to the environment to help their camper feel more comfortable and ensure their safety.
- GROW buddies anticipate possible triggers and have been given individualized strategies unique to their camper to help their camper succeed at KAMPJAM.
