

Celebrating God's Original Plan

(Genesis 2:18-25)

1) Affirm the Dignity of Both Men and Women (Genesis 1:26-28)

- God Created Male and Female Equally (Gen. 1:26-27)
- Both Male and Female were told to "Subdue" the earth (Gen. 1:28)
- God does not value men over women (Numbers 27:6-7)
- Men and women are to be treated equal (Gal. 3:28)
- Men and women both have been empowered for ministry.

A few considerations:

- Acts 21:9 Phillip's four daughters
- Acts 2 sons and daughters prophesy
- First ones to tell of the risen Christ were women
- 1 Cor. 11:5 when a woman prays for prophesies let her head be covered.

2) Acknowledge the **Differences** of Men and Women

General Differences include:

- **Strength** (Men Physical; Women Relational)
- **Speech** (Men not as verbal; Women more verbal)
- **Support** (Men Providers; Women Nurturers)
- Security (Men Protectors; Women Nesters)
- Success (Men Achievers; Women Connectors)
- **Sensitivity** (Men insensitive; women sensitive)
- **Solving Problems** (Men rational; Women emotional)

3) Appreciate the **Design** of Marriage (Genesis 2:18-25)

FROM Genesis 2:18-25:

- Marriage is ordained by God.
- Marriage is between a man and a woman. (no homosexuality)
- Marriage is between ONE man and ONE woman. (no polygamy)

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Marriage has been
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DISMISSED as irrelevant;

DEMEANED as a career buster;

DELAYED for selfish reasons;

DISCOURAGED by those who have been hurt;

DISRESPECTED by Hollywood and the entertainment industry;

REDEFINED by our society, so it no longer holds the meaning as outlined in Scripture
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Hebrews 13:4 (Amplified Bible) <u>Let marriage be held in honor (esteemed worthy, precious, of great price, and especially dear) in all things.</u>

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(ICB) Marriage should be honored by everyone. (NLT) Give honor to marriage
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Marriage is to be honored by all believers. The word "honor" means highly esteemed, counted as the most precious, warm and tender bond, held as the most valuable of bonds, as being the dearest of relationships.

Honored, respected, distinguished, celebrated, esteemed, highly regarded.

Why We should honor marriage:

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Healthy Society (or Helps a Healthy Society) (Prov. 14:34)
Oneness between one Man and one Woman (1 Cor. 11:11)
Necessary for Population (Malachi 2:15; Genesis 1:28)
Offers Protection to Children (Proverbs 14:26; Ephesians 6:4; Matthew 12:29; 1 Cor. 16:13)
Reflects Christ and the Church (Ephesians 5:25-33)
Experience Physical Intimacy (Exodus 20:14; 1 Cor. 7:1-3)
Develops Your Character (Proverbs 18:1)
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Ways we can honor marriage today:

- Receive Marriage is a Gift from God to You. (Singleness is also a gift. read 1 Cor. 7:7)
- Resolve to Fight for Your Marriage. (Remember that Marriage is a Covenant, not a Contract)
- **Refuse to Allow Society to Redefine Marriage For You.** (The Supreme Court of the universe has already ruled on the matter.)
