

HYMNS THAT INSPIRE PRAYER

A hymn is a type of song, and partially synonymous with devotional song, specifically written for the purpose of adoration or prayer, and typically addressed to a deity or deities, or to a prominent figure or personification. The word hymn derives from Greek ὕμνος (hymnos), which means "a song of praise". Church hymns are a form of worship. They serve as a prayer of thanks and an expression of commitment. Is singing hymns a form of prayer?

Augustine, the great fifth-century bishop of North Africa, who said, "Those who sing pray twice."

The words of our hymns are prayers, and when we sing them, we add to them a further dimension of honor and praise. Fifteen times, the Old Testament tells us to "sing to the LORD."
