CHILDHOOD Faith Formation

Faith formation is happening even earlier than we thought. Recent research by Dr. George Barna shows that a person's worldview begins developing around 18 months old and is fully formed by 13 years old.

We cannot wait until our kids grow up to intentionally and lovingly disciple them. Childhood discipleship is paramount for carrying out the Great Commission and building God's kingdom. Discipleship centers around these 3 key ideas:

Belong

Biblical discipleship is built on relationships. Children will learn more from walking alongside of you as you live out your faith than they will learn from any lesson or class.

"Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ."

1 Corinthians 11:1

Believe

Point your children to the truth of scripture at every opportunity. Our children will learn to trust God's word as they see the most important adults in their life open the Bible, read the Bible, speak of God in everyday ordinary conversations and prioritize gathering together in the local church.

"but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name." John 20:31

Become

Beyond sharing God's word, share God's works in your own life. What are the miracles that you've witnessed? The stories of God's faithfulness in your own life? Consider journaling some of the examples of God's faithfulness that are most important to you so that you are able to share this legacy of faith with your children now and into the future.
