**Sight & Sound's "Noah"**

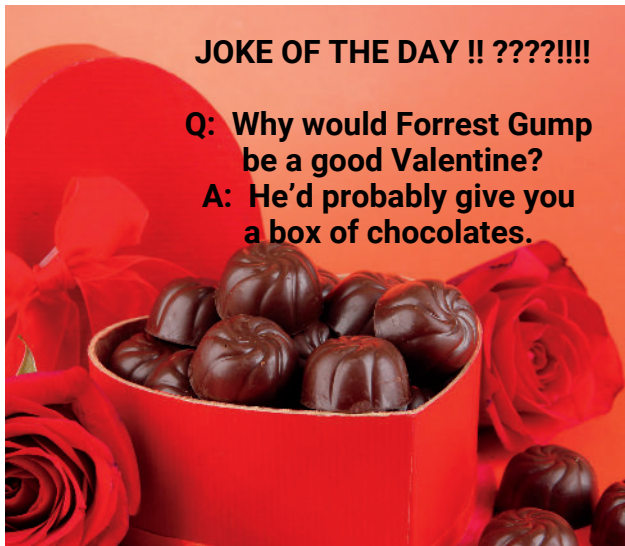
**& American Music Theater's Christmas Show**
