


Because of your support, hundreds of our partners overseas are reaching refugees, orphans, widows, and impoverished people in every corner of the earth with the hope of Jesus Christ.

In Northern Nigeria, clean water is a rare commodity. According to the 2018 Nigeria Demographic and Health Survey, approximately 60% of the region is without reliable access to safe drinking water. People must travel up to 12 miles or use nearby contaminated sources like streams and puddles, if they are available. Waterborne diseases are common and often lead to death.

These areas are also often populated by unreached or least-reached people groups. Islam is the primary religion, with Christians being generally unaccepted or even persecuted. Reaching the villages of Northern Nigeria with the gospel has been a significant challenge, leaving this region both physically and spiritually dry.

However, God is bringing restoration to this desert land. Your gifts to Send Relief gave local believers the resources to dig 44 wells in villages across the region. This project gave over 42,000 people access to clean drinking water, allowing them to live healthier, safer lives.

The impact on these villages is immeasurable. People were overwhelmed and overjoyed to receive such a life-altering resource. The fact that it was provided by Christians completely shifted perspectives and tore down walls of resistance to the gospel. So far, these 44 wells have resulted in 620 people in Northern Nigeria coming to know the Lord, 127 baptisms, and at least 90 new small groups formed to worship and hear God's Word.



CARE FOR REFUGEES

Every day, refugees are forced to leave everything to find security, opportunity, and a new place to call home. Often, they enter a country with few resources and no ability to speak, read, or understand the local language. They arrive with tremendous dreams, but their needs leave them vulnerable to exploitation and abuse.

Your gifts allow our partners to walk with refugees on their journey, protecting them and helping them adapt through intentional support and genuine friendship.

In April 2023, civil war erupted in Sudan between the Sudanese Armed Forces and Rapid Support Forces, affecting the people of this nation in catastrophic ways. Today, nearly 8.5 million people have been displaced internally, with 3 million others fleeing to neighboring countries. This means Sudan has more displaced people than any other country in the world. More than half the population—30.4 million people—are in need of humanitarian aid, and 750,000 are on the verge of starvation.

At Send Relief, we are dedicated to bringing help and hope to the people of Sudan during this time of extreme crisis. Since the start of the conflict, your support has enabled us to implement 28 projects to assist Sudanese people in the country and surrounding nations. So far, we have provided food assistance to 77,493 people, helped 12,352 find shelter, shared the gospel with 58,298, and rejoiced as 1,342 have accepted Christ as their Savior.





Around the world, children suffer from malnutrition, limited resources, and a lack of educational opportunities. At Send Relief, we seek opportunities to be part of the solution, finding ways to offer safety and support to the next generation.

CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

In Armenia, life for children with special needs is often a difficult one. A lack of accessible education and rehabilitation services—in addition to prevalent cultural stigmas around people with disabilities—commonly results in isolation, limiting their opportunities to attend school and interact socially. In some situations, shame will drive families to hide these children from the public, rarely allowing them to leave the walls of their homes. In 2024, your gifts provided a sense of normalcy and relief for a group of children with special needs.

Every year, our local partners in Armenia organize a three-day summer camp specifically for special needs children and their families. This year, 51 children, 41 mothers, and 64 local volunteers attended. It was an incredible opportunity to show the love of Jesus to a population often forgotten by the rest of the world.

During this camp, children with disabilities were able to meet and build relationships with similarly abled kids, feeling acceptance as opposed to the rejection they normally face. Volunteers provided fun, interesting, joy-filled entertainment specifically catered to the campers and their needs.

This camp also provides a respite for mothers who had a chance to rest, knowing that their kids were being cared for in a safe, loving environment. They had time for recreation and connection with other moms, a rare and needed opportunity. When they were presented with the gospel message, many put their faith in Jesus.





FIGHT HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Victims of human trafficking are just like you. They are daughters and sons. They are in your community and around the world. They are often hidden in plain sight.

Send Relief is actively working to help individuals escape the bondages of modern-day slavery, while also working to provide opportunities that empower vulnerable people to never fall prey to it in the first place. Your gifts enable them to live free.

At 16 years old, Leah was lured unexpectedly into the world of human trafficking and, for far too long, lived a life no person of any age should ever have to endure.

For years, she grappled with addiction and constantly found herself in unsafe, compromising situations. However, she encountered hope at the Las Vegas Send Relief Ministry Center. Team members there paired her with a mentor who has poured into her and supported her on her addiction and recovery journey. This has shown Leah what a healthy, trusting relationship looks like.

Now, Leah has fought to get sober and is taking active steps to live a restored life. She has learned she is worth fighting for and that her life has a purpose. Most importantly, she understands what Christians really mean when they talk about "the love of Christ."

Because of your gifts, many men and women are hearing and responding to the gospel through our Las Vegas Ministry Center. The FBI has identified Las Vegas as a "High Intensity Child Prostitution Area." Young people like Leah are taken advantage of every day. Your gifts allow our Las Vegas Ministry Center to share the hope of Christ with these vulnerable people who need it so desperately.





RESPOND TO CRISIS

Natural and man-made disasters are altering families and communities in unimaginable ways all over the world. It's hard to hold on to hope, but your support of Send Relief sends that hope.

We respond to crises in many ways, from supplying food and generators to providing temporary shelters. When you give, you are giving hurting communities the ability to heal physically, spiritually, and emotionally. In the wake of this destruction, support from Southern Baptist churches and the work of trained volunteers from all over the country made an enormous impact in the lives of hurting families. Local churches are there long after the crisis has passed. Crisis response helps those churches win the right to be heard in sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ.

One of these families was the McKinneys in North Carolina. After Helene washed a wall of mud through their home, they had no idea how to begin the clean-up process. Ben McKinney was feeling completely overwhelmed when he saw Southern Baptist Disaster Relief volunteers walking up his driveway.
