Serving in Jesus' Name Ministry mountvernon.church/missions

Serving in Jesus' Name started in 2016 with the goal of sharing the love and Word of God with children in Kenya. Today, our Kenyan network includes 70 orphanges & schools which have 29,000 children. Our outreach includes distributing Bibles & other Scriptural materials, painting Scripture on buildings, establishing Bible clubs, and sharing the Gospel during every visit. Through our partnership with Child Evangelism Fellowship, we introduced the first Bible clubs to the Western Region of Kenya. Thank you for your incredible support of the recent Bible collection thanks to your generosity these Bibles will be added to the 25,000 that have already been shipped to Kenya.

What moment from the field most shaped your faith and ministry?

Serving as church planters in Bogota, Colombia deeply shaped our faith. From language school in Costa Rica to life in Colombia, we saw God at work in every step. Our kids grew in faith alongside us and quickly became fluent in Spanish-often better than us! It was a season of growth, challenge, and joy.

How did serving others strengthen your walk with God?

While in Bogota, we saw neighborhood women attend craft classes that led to Bible study groups-their faith grew, and so did ours! Later, serving in Member Care across the Middle East and Europe, we witnessed God's faithfulness as He protected and provided for workers in hard places. Though we didn't speak all the languages, His love and presence always connected us. Encouraging others deepened our trust in His direction and strengthened our walk with Him.

What does living the Great Commission look like now?

Though no longer on the mission field, we continue to follow God's lead. Jerry now serves as Associate Pastor for Pastoral Care and Kathy stays active with decorating for church events, serving in Children's Ministry and co-leading Wednesday morning Bible Study. Our mission to love, encourage, and share Christ remains unchanged.
