THE IMPORTANCE OF Bible Literacy

"Nothing less than a whole BIble can make a whole Christian." -A. W. Tozer

The State of the Bible USA 2024 (American Bible Society) shows that the percentage of the American population that reads the Bible at least 3 to 4 times a year has declined from **50%** in 2011 to **38%** in 2024. The percentage of Americans engaging in Scripture at least once every week has declined from **33%** in 2011 to **18%** in 2024.

Families, our children will not accidentally become actively engaged in scripture. The world around us is devaluing scripture more and more each year. One of the best ways we can set our kids up for scripture engagement is to provide a strong foundation of Bible Literacy-their ability to know and use God's word with increasing confidence and independence.

How do we build Bible Literacy?

Build Bible knowledge. Key concepts to teach:

- 1. The Bible is God's word, inspired by the Holy Spirit.
- 2. The Bible is perfect, true, and complete.
- 3. The Bible teaches us about God the Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit.
- 4. The Bible instructs us in how we should live.

Practice Bible skills. Key skills to know:

- 1. Identify parts of the Bible.
- 2. Identify and find the books of the Bible.
- 3. Practice reading the names of Bible people and places.
- 4. Practice opening the Bible to find a specific verse.

Strengthen application of God's word.

- 1. Read God's word together, and follow up with discussion. Ask "What did we learn about God?" "What did we learn that He wants us to do?"
- 2. When discussing real life choices and dilemmas, ask, "What does God think about this? How do you know?"
- 3. Study the lives of heroes of the faith, real life examples of men and women who lived out God's word throughout history.
