AIM (Alpha International Ministries) begain 55 years ago, when two ordinary people from India made an extraordinary leap of faith. They left everything behind to spread the gospel in a region where only .05% of the population were Christians. They traveled 1,319 miles to minister to a city in South Asia where they would be ostracized, experience great loss, and be persecuted for their faith. AIM's mission is to raise hereos of faith who provide hope to hurting communities with the gospel. They equip national leaders around the world to spread the gospel through missions training, church planting, and community projects. AIM primarly works in regions where Christ's name is least heard.

Leslie van den Berg Summer Missionary to Thailand

Can you share a little about your past experience serving overseas and how that shaped your faith and calling. I've loved missions since my first trip at age 12. After teaching in North Carolina, God called me overseas to teach in Shanghai and later in Taiwan, where I shared both academics and the gospel with students from around the world. In 2018, God clearly led me back to the U.S., and I've continued to follow His call ever since.

What will your mission work in Thailand involve during your stay in July?

I'll be working with AIM under Tanya's leadership, visiting various ministry sites to observe and support their work-such as child & pastor sponsorships, refugee ministry, and teaching English. I'll also help lead the children's sessions at a Family Camp, focusing on music & VBS-style activities. This is a visioning trip to explore future involvement

I'm so grateful for the encouragement, prayers, and generous support I've received-it's been a clear reminder that God is guiding and providing every step of the way.
