August 30

September 2

- Pray for the local pastors & churches to be blessed & encouraged in ministry. Pray that their churches will grow and that lives & families will be transformed by the gospel & God's Word. Pray for the Lord to meet each of their needs.

September 4

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, ver believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

- Pray for the Holy Spirit to strengthen, encourage, and use us in a mighty way today & for divine appointments. Pray that we will focus our hearts on what the Lord wants for us today.
