



ARTS BREAKOUT DESCRIPTIONS:

Art: Kids will participate in visual arts experiences, including painting, drawing, and other crafts, which will be displayed in an art show during the Friday night production. **This option can be found in both the Performing Arts & Fine Arts Tracks.**

***New this year* CAB (Creative Artistic Builders):** This group is designed after the STEAM concept in learning. By engaging in collaborative and experiential problem-solving exercises, kids will create and build activities in which other campers will participate. Projects may include Lego construction, obstacle course creation, scavenger hunt designing, domino maze building, etc. **This option is only available in the Fine Arts Track.**

***New this year* Cartooning:** Kids will participate in this specific art genre by creating cartoon-like images of words, images, and people that will appear within the onstage presentation and art show during the Friday night production. **This option can be found in both the Performing Arts & Fine Arts Tracks.**

Choir: Kids will participate in the choir, singing the music that will accompany the other arts presentations and connect the scenes within the drama during the Friday night production. **This option is only available in the Performing Arts Track.**

***New this year* Costume Design:** Kids will learn sewing techniques and create some of the costumes and props that will be used during the Friday night production. **This option is only available in the Performing Arts Track.**

Dance: Kids will learn and memorize choreography and dance movements, to present to the audience during the Friday night production. **This option is only available in the Performing Arts Track.**

Drama: The drama group is for those kids in 4th & 5th Grade who are cast in an acting part after being chosen through the audition process. Kids must be able to attend auditions on either Wednesday, May 27 from 6:15pm-7:30pm or Sunday, May 31 from 4pm-5:30pm. Kids who are cast must be in attendance for all days during camp week and be able to attend the final production on Friday, June 26 at 6:30pm. **This option is only available in the Performing Arts Track.**

Drumming/Percussion: Kids will play various ethnic drums and percussion instruments (such as bongos, hand drums, djembes, frame drums, boomwhackers) and learn a group piece of music to present to the audience during the Friday night production. **This option is only available in the Performing Arts Track.**

Puppetry: Kids will learn how to use puppets in presenting the gospel. They will prepare a puppet piece and present their final work during the Friday night production. **This option is only available in the Performing Arts Track.**

***New this year* Set Design:** Kids will use painting and drawing to create props and set pieces that will be used for the Friday night production. **This option is only available in the Fine Arts Track.**

***New this year* Show Choir:** The show choir is for those kids in 1st-5th grade who like to both sing and dance simultaneously. This group will be chosen through an audition process. Kids must be able to attend auditions on either Wednesday, May 27 6:15pm-7:30pm or Sunday, May 31 4pm-5:30pm and must be able to attend the final production on Friday, June 26 at 6:30pm. **This option is only available in the Performing Arts Track.**

Sign Language: Kids will learn sign language to interpret a designated piece of music. The interpretive piece will then be presented to the audience during the Friday night production. **This option is only available in the Performing Arts Track.**

Snack Chefs: Kids will create the snacks that will be served daily to the campers during snack time or prepare the snacks that will be served during the reception following the Friday night production. All snacks will be theme-based to go along with the subject of the musical. **This option can be found in both the Performing Arts & Fine Arts Tracks.**

Stop Motion Technology: Kids will learn how to use stop motion animation and create a video to be shared during the Friday night production. Stop motion animation is a filming technique in which objects (such as clay models) are photographed in a series of slightly different positions so that the objects seem to move. Kids will be required to provide their own portable device, such as a tablet or smartphone. **This option is only available in the Fine Arts Track.**

Videography: Kids will participate in the creation of videos that will be used during the Friday night production. **This option is only available in the Fine Arts Track.**
