*This special offering supplements and helps support ministries and mission efforts, **not** the Associational budget.*

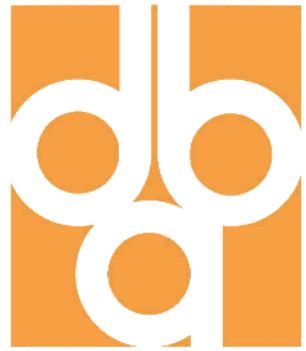
Suggestions for Promoting the Month of Prayer for Association Missions

Month of Prayer Emphasis for Dover Baptist Association Missions 2026

Famaden Memorial Institute

Pray for Pastor Joe Reeves and other staff at the Famaden Memorial Institute in Liberia, Africa. Famaden Memorial Institute includes a church, school, rec and resource centers, and health clinic all designed to help and reach the community, in a predominantly Muslim area, with the Gospel message.



Raceway Ministries

Pray for Central Virginia Raceway Ministries and for more volunteers. The gifts we and others give help pay the cost of providing a Gospel witness and ministry to fans and workers at Richmond Raceway.

Hunger/Food Insecurity

Pray for the food insecure within our Association and the churches that minister to them. Pray for provision and energy of the volunteers and the people who give to alleviate hunger and poverty.



Addiction, Recovery, & Personal Crisis Ministries

Pray for those battling addiction, pursuing recovery, with unplanned pregnancies, and those with mental illness or health crises. Pray for the supporters of those who face these oft-lonely challenges: The Fix Ministry, The McShin Foundation, The Pregnancy Resource Center of Metro Richmond, CrossOver Healthcare Ministry.

Homelessness and Refugee Ministries

Pray for those who are in need of stable housing and families, as well as asylum. Pray also for those who help to provide resources to them such as HopeTree Family Services, Moments of Hope Outreach, International Ministry of Ashland, and Baptist inner city missions.

Special Needs Ministries

Pray for those who have special needs, their caregivers, and the communities that celebrate them, such as Night to Shine RVA. Pray that the Gospel is shared in both word and deed to and through this community.



Unique Local and Global Ministries

Pray for ministries meeting unique needs and sharing the Gospel both here and across the globe, such as Sylvia's Sisters and 28:19 Ministries. Standing Rock Reservation Ministry
