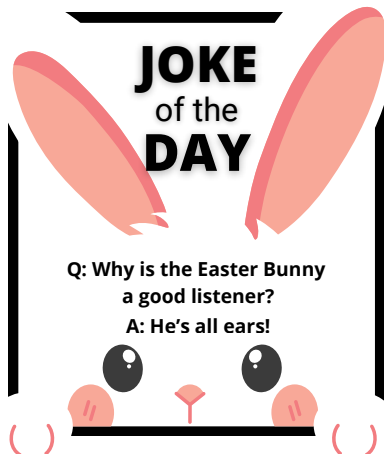

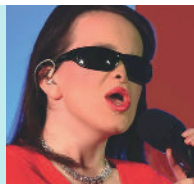
Mount Vernon Preschool Mount Vernon's Musical Talent Thursday, May 7
